I confirm that I have read and acknowledge the following warning: Parents and Guardians are warned that the club is only able to provide rescue facilities during the hours of Club Sessions. Outside these hours, parents and guardians have sole responsibility for their children and wards and must appreciate that the Club cannot be expected to exercise supervision or control. Even during Club sessions the Club cannot accept responsibility for children, or any other person, not engaged in sailing.

If any other member wishes to perform a duty place a tick against the person's name in the appropriate column for that duty.

	Safety Boat Crew	To provide assistance to any craft in difficulties, including being suitably equipped to enter the water to right a capsized craft or to help a person trapped in the craft. MUST have a wet or dry suit for the period 1st November to 30th April.
	Beach Master	To coordinate activity on beach and slipways and prevent congestion around the Clubhouse.
	Assistant Race Officer	To assist the Race Officer in the race management.
	Powerboat Helm	MUST have Powerboat Level 2 certificate and preferably RYA Safety Boat.
RYA Qualifications	If any person's listed hold RYA qualifications please tick against each qualification held by that person's name.

Full	Open to any person over 18 on subscription due date. Entitles named main member, spouse and children under 21 on subscription due date to use of all the facilities. Named member has FULL voting rights and is obliged to perform a rostered duty.	
Young Adult	Open to any person age 18 and 25 on subscription due date. Entitles member to use all facilities. Has NO voting rights. Named main member is obliged to perform a rostered duty.	
Junior	Open to any person under 18 on the subscription due date. Entitles main member to use all facilities (except the bar). May enrol one adult as a social member free. Has NO voting rights and is NOT obliged to perform a rostered duty.	
Winter	As for Full (family) but only for the period from 1 st October in any one year to the 31 st March in the following year but has NO voting rights. Named main member is obliged to perform a rostered duty.	
Young Winter	As for Young Adult but only for the period from 1 st October in any one year to the 31 st March in the following year. Has NO voting rights. Named main member is obliged to perform a rostered duty.	
Junior Winter	As Junior but only for the period from 1 st October in any one year to the 31 st March in the following year.
