From 4 July social distancing remains at 2 meters unless you use mitigating measures which allow a reduction to 1 metre plus. Max six people involved in the activity if from different household-groups are not to interact Wear disposable gloves during activity. Remove and place in plastic bag to take home before washing hands using sanitiser at the 'station' set up by Markerstudy outside the Offices/Bistro or using sanitiser in MoB HQ prior to departing/getting into car We have a NHS QR Code which should be scanned if you are able to, otherwise contact information will be retained re Test and Trace. Activity limited to once a week with more than 72hrs between any activity to reduce risk from touching hard	Medium. Members are permitted to take part in MoB activity, if they choose to do so.
	All members	Medium	Water based activity	Maintain social distancing except when in company of those living in the same household. <i>From 4 July social distancing remains at 2 meters unless you use mitigating measures which allow a reduction to 1 metre plus.</i> Assistance with preparing boat, launching and recovery will be available as per our Covid Operating Guidance and Procedures, as long as social distancing is adhered to. <i>However, if support is needed with getting into or out of a boat, this can only be provided by a member of your household/support bubble.</i> Members MUST be competent if single handed sailing and multi crew boats must have a competent helm on board. We have a NHS QR Code which should be scanned if you are able to, otherwise contact information will be retained re Test and Trace. Activity limited to once a week with more than 72hrs between any activity to reduce risk from touching hard	Medium. Members are permitted to take part in MoB activity if they choose to do so

Manning of a safety boat limited to one person wherever possible. If a tow is required this should wherever possible be from astern	Low.
